### CLASSES LIMITED TO 55 RUNS PER TRIAL CONCURRENT TRIALS

HD entrants move from Trial 1 search directly to Trial 2 search, at the same level.  
Interior entrants will ALL complete Trial 1 before Trial 2 begins.

**SEARCHES are all INDOORS in AIR-CONDITIONED space.**

CRATING will be outside at your vehicle. GASOLINE generators are not allowed,  
and gasoline running vehicles must be parked away from other exhibitors.

### HANDLER DISCRIMINATION DIVISION

Handlers are required to provide their own scented item in a plastic bag.  
NOVICE: cotton glove or sock; ADVANCED: cotton ball  
You may enter multiple dogs in HD in a single trial.

### TRANSFERS WILL BE ALLOWED

The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each Trial. Transfers may be approved provided the next level class and judge is available and the class has not reached its limit. Please contact the Trial Secretary for a transfer form, or download it from AKC.org (downloadable forms).

### DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

**AGE:** This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older. **REGISTRATION:** Dogs must be registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with PAL/ILP, Canine Partners must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. "Dog" refers to both sexes.

**HEALTH:** Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees, deafness and blindness) are eligible to participate based upon the opinion of the judge. Dogs with physical injury (including mental or physical illness, sutures and bandages) and females in season may NOT participate. Aggressive dogs may not participate.

**TITLE:** Dogs entering upper level searches must hold the title in prior level class. Three qualifying scores are required to earn a title.

### ENTRY FEES PER TRIAL

Each entry (includes a \$3.50 AKC recording fee) ..... \$25 per dog per trial 1<sup>st</sup> entry  
additional entries of the same dog in the same trial.....\$15 each add'l entry

### WAIT LIST INFORMATION

OTCPBC is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 20 entries per day will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the posted closing date/time. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing date/time unless a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund.

### RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

First Place.....Blue Rosette  
Second Place.....Red Rosette  
Third Place.....Yellow Rosette  
Fourth Place.....White Rosette  
Qualifying Score.....Dark Green flat

A **New Title** rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

**High in Trial** (Ch 6, Section 8) This show is not eligible for HIT awards.

HIT is awarded at each level, to the teams with the fewest faults with qualifying scores in all elements at the same level offered in that trial.

Prizes are offered by the Obedience Training Club of Palm Beach County and its friends and members. A qualifying score is required for all ribbons & prizes. Awards and prizes must be picked up in person or by a designated representative on the day of the Trial. No awards will be mailed. Unclaimed awards become the property of OTCPBC. OTCPBC reserves the right to substitute an award or prize of equal value.

### NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

#### **SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY**

The **safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that **exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children**. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Obedience Training Club of Palm Beach County (OTCPBC) and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. OTCPBC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against OTCPBC or any official thereof.

IF IT IS NECESSARY TO RESCUE A DOG from a parked car on the show grounds, the Club will not be responsible or liable for any damage to the car involved. Unattended cars containing dogs should display contact information for a responsible adult at the show.

**REFUNDS** No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are NOT eligible for a refund. Bitches in season WILL be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour PRIOR to the start of the first class of the day of the trial. OTCPBC reserves the right of representation and **Claims** will NOT be settled solely by arbitration as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

#### **ENTRY FORM ERRORS & OMISSIONS**

Per AKC, the Trial Secretary is **NOT** responsible for incorrect or missing information on the entry form. The Trial Secretary will try to obtain missing information but it is not their responsibility. Any information must be sent in WRITING thru regular mail or in an E-mail. If the class is entered wrong by the secretary a correction will be made.

### CHECK IN

Exhibitors MUST check-in EACH day they are entered.

At check-in you will receive your armband number. Once the time and location for check-in is determined all exhibitors will be notified by email.

**NO dogs at the check in table please.**

**There will be a porta-potty in the parking area and no indoor restroom access**

### WARM UP

Warm up area will consist of ONE container of Birch (Novice), Anise (Advanced), Clove (Excellent), or Cypress (Master) and may also consist of blank containers. Please limit warm-up to 2 minutes. No elimination or training in the warm up area. Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The club is not responsible for locating late dogs. Only one dog/handler team at the warm up area at a time. A steward will instruct your team movement to and from the warm up area for staging.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Collars, Leashes: While not actively searching, dogs **MUST** be curbed to a 6' leash, including entering and exiting search areas. During searches, the judge will determine leash use. Collars and leashes shall meet requirements set forth in the rules for scent work. Go Pro is allowed attached to a harness, retractable leashes allowed only during searches if allowed by the judge.

Site: It is not appropriate to visit the trial location prior to the trial date. Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5. Section 26 of the Scent Work Regulations state only the trial administrator will have scent/odor at the trial site. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial.

Crating: Participants are required to crate at their vehicles. Please be aware of the weather on the trial date. There will be a porta-potty for participant and spectator use in the parking and crating area.

Clean up: Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Please use the pea gravel elimination area.

### SPECTATOR AREA

Spectators are encouraged. Any person not handling a dog in the current class, or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the DESIGNATED spectator area. Only Handler Discrimination classes can be watched by anyone. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be asked to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search with handlers who have not run. Spectators should not cheer or applaud until the team is leaving the search area once the judge indicates the search is completed

### ENTRY FEE CALCULATION SAMPLE

I want to enter Novice Handler Discrimination all four trials: \$100

I want to enter Novice HD and Novice Interior all four trials: \$160

I want to enter Novice & Advanced Interior (I already have Novice title and want to earn Elite legs) all four trials: \$160

I want to enter Saturday 2 trials, HD only: \$50

I want to enter Saturday 2 trials, HD Novice & Advanced, Interior Novice & Advanced (I already have both Novice titles and will gain Elite legs): \$140

I want to enter Saturday, trial 2 in NOVICE, ADVANCED AND EXCELLENT (I already have the Novice and Advanced titles and will earn Elite legs): \$55

I only need 1 more leg in Novice, should I enter later trials in Advanced? No, You are only eligible for Novice (until you earn the Novice title). Once you earn the 3 Novice legs, you may complete a transfer form and submit it to the Trial Secretary. See the section on Transfers.
