**Regular & Optional Titling Classes:** Entry fee for these classes shall be \$27.00 per dog for the **FIRST** entry. (\$17.00 for a second entry of the **SAME DOG** in the **SAME** trial). **RETURNED** Checks will be charged a \$25 return check fee.

**Injuries** - Dogs that cannot compete due to an injury will be given a refund minus \$5.00 per trial per entry if the trial has already closed. A **written vet letter must be given to the Trial Secretary no later than 30 minutes before the start time on the date of the trial.** Bitches that come into season will also receive a refund as stated above minus a vet letter. If the trial has not closed, a full refund will be given.

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any condition as to its acceptance. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as possible. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.
