Obedience Training Club of Palm Beach County (OTCPBC) General Membership Meeting – Via Zoom Meeting Monday, August 3, 2020

Board Members Present: Betty Gansky, Steve Campbell, Celeste Platte, Fran Smith, Nancy Honchar, Tracey Guziejka, Scott Adams

President Report – Betty Gansky: The club has high grade disinfectant to wipe down the jumps and table. There is now sanitizing machines by the front door as well as the table. No touch thermometer for all class participants.

Vice President Report - Steve Campbell: Anyone that had an active access card when the building closed has had one, two, or three months added to their expiration time. Steve will let card holders know 15 days before their card expires. All access cards should now be working.

Training Schedule for private time seems to be going well. Steve is using text to take and verify times to train.

Treasurer's Report – Fran Smith: We had to do several refunds and months without any income, so our reserves are down considerably, but we have enough money in the bank to carry us. Even though the building was closed, we still have ongoing expenses. Taxes are coming up in the coming months. Depending on how the club does in the fall, the club may have a loss for the year.. Betty stated that she is frequently questioned why we have so much money in the bank. This is the reason. Unexpected things happen and you need a cushion to carry the club through unforeseen events. Fran commented that there are other clubs in Florida that are in direr straights monetarily and have put out "Go Fund Me" requests.

Scent Work Coordinator – Judy McPartland: four classes on Tuesday night and two on Saturday. More classes at those times when these are classes are finished. Judy and Marti Hohmann both got accredited by the National Association of Canine Scent Work (NACSW).

Obedience Coordinator – Nancy Honchar: We are on our second round of classes. We had a healthy response. In the Fall, hopefully will have more classes as more instructors become available. We are being as vigilant with sanitizing and social distancing as we can.

Secretary Report as well as Obedience Trials – Celeste Platte. The Obedience Trial on September 26 & 27 is going to be a little different. Make sure you read the premium completely to understand the changes.

Agility Coordinator – Barbara Bounds: Two agility classes ongoing. Four students each class. Wearing masks. She is getting inquiries about the fall classes. More classes will be offered outside in the fall.

Rally Coordinator – Steve Campbell – Classes/trials. Two classes are finishing up and three classes starting shortly. Masters. Excellent and a Novice Class. Trials are scheduled for September 12 & 13. Only one trial per day instead of the usual two. Bob Millar is judging. Hopefully, we can have a Rally Show and Go before the show. The premium is posted on the website. There is a new Coronavirus guideline that the exhibitors are required to sign.

Lead Lines – Lori Patterson. DEADLINE August 17, 2020 for next issue. No tracking tests at this time.

New Business

Future Show & Go's – Nancy Honchar & Steve Campbell. Nancy: Hopefully an obedience show and go (S & G) in September prior to the trial. May use same format at the trial to keep distancing to the minimum requirement. Nancy wants to hold the S & G on one day. Weekend before the obedience trial. Steve: At this time a Rally Show and Go is being planned for September 6.

Board of Directors Motion: Motion made by Fran Smith, seconded by Nancy Honchar Approved by at the Board of Director's meeting of June 22, 2020: Silver/Gold members of OTCPBC no longer need to accumulate the required number of volunteer hours needed to purchase an access card. They will however still be required to purchase the card. The Board felt that after 25+ years of membership the volunteer hour requirement will no longer be required of them.

Pavilion progress in the Agility field – Tracey Guziejka: The work has been done with permits, etc. The permit is good thru the spring of 2020. Week of August 10 excavate the area and prepare the ground to install the slab. Then inspection. After inspection, the slab will be poured. At that time, we will order the actual structure. 6 – 8 weeks to be delivered. One day to install. Anticipated October installation weather permitting. 12 x 20 surface. The pavilion sits on the slab. There will be a fan and light installed. This is just for crating dogs. Any damage to the ground will be addressed after the slab is installed. Caution must be exercised because there will be rods, etc. sticking up for the slab pour. It will be very dangerous. No one will be able to use the field during this time. The whole process took a lot longer than anticipated due to the pandemic.

All classes will be continued, and all trials scheduled at this time will continue.






Under Quarantine restrictions, we participated in many at-home trials. Before competing, I had to create

To complete at home trials, you must video a clear round, despite distractions such as neighbor's dogs fence running, yard workers mowing and trimming, birds bathing in gutters, gekkos running across the teeter, the sun, rain, heat, building my own courses, and learning the new rules for qualifying runs. Despite all of that, I was able to study the course maps, plan my runs, manage to catch them on video, and get the technology to comply with submitting the videos on time. We feel very accomplished.
