CLASSES LIMITED TO 62 RUNS PER TRIAL

Interior SEARCHES are all INDOORS in AIR-CONDITIONED space.

HD Novice and Excellent will be held outside on concrete or grass.

CRATING will be outside at your vehicle. GASOLINE generators are not allowed, and gasoline running vehicles must be parked away from other exhibitors.

HANDLER DISCRIMINATION DIVISION

Handler Discrimination classes are titling classes in which the targeted scent is that of the handler themselves. Handlers are required to provide their own scented articles in a plastic bag.

Novice class, one cotton glove or cotton sock.

Advanced, Excellent, and Master, cotton balls or cotton swabs.

TRANSFERS

Transfers are not allowed between TRIAL 1 and TRIAL 2 on Saturday or Sunday.

The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each Day. Transfers may be approved provided the next level class and judge is available and the class has not reached its limit.

Please contact the Trial Secretary for a transfer form or download it from AKC.org(downloadable forms).

No entries will be accepted by phone, email, fax, or hand delivery. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted, which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a \$25.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

WAIT LIST

OTCPBC is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial’s closing date/time. A maximum of 20 entries per day will be placed on the club’s wait list. All entries, including wait-listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary prior to the posted closing date/time. No entries may be withdrawn with a refund after closing date/time unless a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial will receive a full refund. The wait list will close on January 21, 2022.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, and PRIZES

Placement ribbons will be awarded in each class as follows:

- First Place Blue Rosette
- Second Place Red Rosette
- Third Place Yellow Rosette
- Fourth Place White Rosette
- Qualifying Score Dark Green flat

A **New Title** rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title.

High in Trial (Ch 6, Section 8)

This show is not eligible for HIT awards.

Prizes are offered by the Obedience Training Club of Palm Beach County and its friends and members. A qualifying score is required for all ribbons & prizes. Awards and prizes must be picked up in person or by a designated representative on the day of the Trial. No awards will be mailed. Unclaimed awards become the property of OTCPBC. OTCPBC reserves the right to substitute an award or prize of equal value.

Qualifying ribbons will be provided by the table steward after the search is successfully completed. Placement ribbons will be awarded at the Check-in area after the class is completed and results are tabulated.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

AGE: This trial is open to all dogs SIX (6) months of age or older.

REGISTRATION: Dogs must be registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate. Dogs with PAL/ILP, Canine Partners must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. "Dog" refers to both sexes.

CONDITION: Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provide that, in the opinion of the judge, they display no signs of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Dogs with bandages, sutures, or visible wounds are not eligible. Deaf dogs and blind dogs are able to enter. Dogs that are both deaf and blind are able to participate so long as the handler is in control of the dog at all times, the dog can complete the requirements of the class, and the dog does not appear to be under undue stress in the opinion of the judge.

TITLE: Dogs entering upper level searches must hold the title in prior level class.

Three qualifying scores are required to earn a title.

SAFETY PROCEDURES

By entering this trial, I affirm that to the best of my knowledge I am COVID-19 free. I also agree to refrain from coming to Trials and competitions at OTCPBC, and to notify OTCPBC, should my condition change. Further, I agree to follow club procedures and guidelines, precautions, and requirements, described in this premium list, to mitigate the possibility of spreading COVID-19. I understand the risks of contracting or being exposed to COVID-19 associated with my attendance at competitions and trials at OTCPBC and I knowingly accept those risks.

A mask is recommended but not required, unless State and Local guidelines change to require one. You will be expected to maintain a social distance of six feet from volunteers and other attendees (as well as their dogs).

PLEASE DO NOT ATTEND IF YOU DO NOT FEEL WELL.

Only the dog handler should attend, no spouses/children/observers unless required for assistance.

Please bring your own crate and chair as desired for comfort in the parking lot.

Please bring your own hand sanitizer or gloves if desired.

Flexi leashes are allowed only when running the dog in a trial class, not while walking to and from the potty area.

A written/paper chart of the run order will be manned at the main entrance and armband numbers will be called. This will be the primary source of run order sequence. Please check to be sure your armband appears on this run order for each class in which you are entered.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of the Regulations for Scent Work Trials at www.akc.org/rules

STAGING AREA

Staging area will be out of view of search area(s). Staging area will include crating, warm-up and waiting area, as well as the secretary table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

This is located from the parking lot, near the front door to the club.

CHECK-IN

EXHIBITOR CHECK-IN: At check-in you will receive your armband number.

Check-in is from 8:00-8:30 daily. Handler Briefing at 8:15, Judging begins at 8:30.

If you are only entered in later classes and do not attend the Handler Briefing, you are responsible for the content and for arriving on time for your classes.

Exhibitors MUST check in EACH day they are entered.

SPECTATOR AREA

Due to COVID-19 mitigation of spread of disease, spectators are prohibited.

No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Volunteer-Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be asked to leave the area by the judge. Volunteer-Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search with handlers who have not run. Volunteer-Spectators should not cheer or applaud until the team is leaving the search area once the judge has indicated the search is completed.

HANDLER'S BRIEFING

The Handler Briefing will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handler's Briefing the judge will explain if there is an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides, and maximum time for the search. NO DOGS are to be present during the Handler's Briefing.

WARM UP AREA

One labelled container per target odor being used in the trial on that day will be placed in the warm-up area. Each team should limit their warm-up to two minutes or less. The run order will allow each team time at the warm-up area prior to moving to the staging area for their search(es).

SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Interior Search Area is indoors, with overhead HVAC vents, black mat flooring.

Exterior Search Area for HD Novice and Excellent is on concrete or grass.

Average ambient temperature is between 60 and 80 degrees Fahrenheit in January.

Search Area Sizes will be as required in the "Regulations for AKC Scent Work."

CRATING

Participants are required to crate at their vehicles. Please be aware of the weather on the trial day. There will be a porta-potty for participants to use in the parking/crating area.

CLEAN UP

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Please use the pea gravel elimination area. Please do not allow your dog(s) to eliminate on any manicured lawns, shrubbery, or buildings in the region. Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund in the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

DIRECTIONS TO THE TRIAL SITE

For GPS Directions: 1250 Gateway Road, Lake Park, FL 33403
From I-95: Take exit #77 (Northlake Blvd.), go East to Old Dixie Hwy. Turn right on Old Dixie (just before RR tracks) and proceed to 3rd right. At Gateway Rd. turn right.
From the FL Turnpike: Take exit #107 (Beeline Hwy. **NEED SUNPASS**) turn right, after exit go to 1st light Northlake Blvd turn right (East). Turn right on Old Dixie Hwy (just before RR tracks) and proceed to 3rd right. At Gateway Rd. turn right. Proceed to end of road. OTCPBC clubhouse is the last building on the left.

ENTRY FEE CALCULATION SAMPLE

Four trials of HD = \$100

Four Trials of HD Novice and Interior Novice = \$160

Saturday Trial 1 and Trial 2 Advanced Interior = \$50 (to add HD Novice, total \$80)

You are allowed one entry per level and a maximum of 2 entries per element, per trial, per dog. (an element is container, exterior, interior, buried, and Handler Discrimination).

I only need 1 more leg in Novice, should I enter later trials in Advanced? No, You are only eligible for Novice (until you earn the Novice title). Once you earn the 3 Novice legs, you may complete a transfer form and submit it to the Trial Secretary. See the section on Transfers.

Please email the Trial Secretary for any other entry combinations that require assistance.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS-SAFETY, BEHAVIOR, and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such **case**, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Obedience Training Club of Palm Beach County (OTCPBC) and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. OTCPBC reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the OTCPBC or any official thereof.

COLLARS, LEASHES, and HARNESSSES

During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a Go Pro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical condition are not eligible for a refund. **Bitches in season** will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing must be given to the trial secretary no later than one half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Claims will be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

TRIAL SITE

It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments, and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

POSSESSION OF ODORS and TRAINING

Chapter 5. Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area".
