ENTRIES

ENTRY LIMIT: 3 VST/2 TDU with substitution (2 TDU = 1 VST) allowed to a maximum total of five (5) tracks. Preference will be given to dogs that do not have a VST title.

ENTRY FEE: \$ 125.00 per VST entry, \$80.00 per TDU entry. (Including a \$3.50 Recording Fee and Event Service Fee in accordance with Dog Show Rules, Chapter 11, Section 2)

Entries must be on official AKC entry forms or photocopy of same including reverse side with agreements and rules.

MAKE CHECKS PAYABLE TO: OTCPBC. No cash or third party checks, please.

ENTRY DRAWING: At 6:00 pm Thursday, December 30, 2021 the Secretary will conduct a random draw of all entries at 1110 Kriss Lane, Jupiter, FL 33458. There will be a separate draw conducted for the AKC Worker Option. Based on the number of tracks offered at this test, there will be one (1) track available for the Worker Option for 3 VST. Immediately after the Worker Option draw another draw will be conducted to determine the remaining entries. When the limit of 5 dogs has been reached, all remaining entries will comprise the alternate list. Alternates have the option to accept or decline being placed on the alternate list. Those that decline will have their entry fee and certifications, if applicable, returned. The Test Secretary will notify all entries of the draw results.

DRAW FOR TRACKS: Sunday, January 10, 2022 at

7:15 AM (TDU) in the Mirasol Publix parking lot, and

9:15 AM (VST) at 6251 PGA Blvd, Palm Beach Gardens, FL 33418

In the event an accepted entry is absent at the draw, the judges shall mark the dog "Absent" if an Alternate is present to draw. The Alternates that are present will be selected to draw by the order on the Alternate's List. If there are no Alternates present, the judges may designate the Test Secretary to draw for the Absent dog. If the Test Secretary has drawn for the absent dog, the dog will be marked absent if it is not present for the running of their track.

ELIGIBILITY

ELIGIBILITY FOR VST TEST: The Variable Surface Tracking Dog test shall be for dogs that have earned the TD or TDU Title. A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the title VST. However, the Tracking Test Secretary shall give dogs not holding a VST title priority for entry in the test.

ELIGIBILITY FOR TDU TEST: The Tracking Dog Urban test shall be for non-TDU titled dogs and dogs that have earned the TD, TDX, VST, or TDU Title. A dog may continue to participate in this test after it has earned the title TDU. However, the Tracking Test Secretary shall give dogs not holding any of the above titles priority for entry in the test. With the entry of a non-TD/TDU titled dog, there must be included an original statement (certification) dated not more than one year prior to the test date, signed by an AKC Tracking Judge, stating that the dog is considered to be ready for the Tracking Dog Urban Test.

Additional information

BITCHES IN SEASON MAY PARTICIPATE: Entrants must notify the Test Secretary and Judges that their Bitch is in season prior to the drawing for tracks. Bitches in season will participate only after all other dogs have been run.

AWARDS: Those dogs marked "PASSED" will receive the final article signed by the judges and tracklayer, a new title rosette and they will be issued a certificate by the AKC.

DIRECTIONS: Take I-95 or Florida's Turnpike to PGA Blvd. Go west past the Turnpike. The Mirasol Publix plaza is on the north side of PGA Blvd. We will be camped from vehicles under the shade trees to the west end of the parking lot. Following the TDU test, the committee will relocate to the 6251 PGA BLVD parking lot for the VST test.
