“The Clever Way to Problem Solve!” Come and join us for two days of Competition Obedience Problem solving! Ann will focus on the Clever ways she fixes common problems found in the obedience ring that keep your team from achieving your goals. Ann will cover what causes these problems, and how to fix them using food, toys, attention games and behavior modification to show the dog the performance we are looking for. You will use these problem-solving skills to build your dog’s confidence and ultimately improve team performance in the ring.

Ann Marie’s Background: Anne's training career started in horses. 1991 she got started in dog training. The last 17 years Ann owned and operated her own dog training school in New Jersey. She moved to Sumterville, Florida in March of 2023. Anne's philosophy is to make competition sports a fun team activity we do with our dogs. She believes the dog first needs a solid behavioral foundation which allows us to use games and motivation to achieve the competition goals. Ann's approach is not a “cookie cutter” approach, each team is treated individually. Ann teaches dogs as small as a Yorkie and as big as a Great Dane. Her accomplishments with their dogs include multiple OTCH’s RACH’S and MACH’s. Multiple 200’s, High in Trials, High Combined and High Triples. Ann finished in the Top Ten in the NOC three years in a row plus multiple wins at Rally Nationals, multiple placements at the AKC Classic and Gains events plus many other nationals.
