Information for Handlers about the Tests

Handlers should be familiar with the temperament descriptions of their dog's breed standard. Please also read AKC's suggestions for the modification of temperament prior to testing.

Dogs must pass two temperament tests under two different evaluators to receive the title. AKC requires variations when tests are offered back to back, so please anticipate minor changes between tests.

Some test items may be retried only once; please familiarize yourself with these stipulations ahead of time.
